the world


Let us pray for the coming of God's kingdom in the words our Saviour taught us.

And so, Father, we remember and celebrate all that Christ has done for us. Send your Holy Spirit that these gifts of bread and wine may be for us


the body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we give ourselves to you. May your Spirit draw us together in the one Body of Christ.
